**CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. Delegates conduct shall be the responsibility of the Club Advisor.
2. Delegates shall be prompt and prepared for all activities.
3. Delegates shall keep their Advisors informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
4. Delegates shall wear identification badges at all times.
5. Delegates shall not deface public property. Any damage to property, furnishings in hotel rooms or buildings shall be paid for by the individual or club responsible.
6. Delegates from out-of-town shall spend the night or nights at assigned hotels, in assigned rooms.
7. Delegates shall be in their respective rooms and quiet at curfew. The curfew time established in the Conference Program will be observed and enforced. Unnecessary noises at any hour shall be avoided in respect to other hotel guests. Hotel regulations must be observed; this includes pool conduct, hours, etc.
8. Delegates shall not be permitted in sleeping rooms of members of the opposite sex, except for supervised group meetings.
9. Delegates shall be prohibited from having alcoholic beverages or drugs in any form.
10. Delegates, including those 18 and over, shall not be permitted to smoke at any scheduled function or while in official SkillsUSA dress. State law prohibits youth under 18 from possessing tobacco at any time.
11. Delegates shall attend all General Sessions and activities for which they are assigned and registered.
12. Official SkillsUSA dress or business attire shall be worn to all official conference functions, particularly the General Sessions, Delegate Assembly and Awards Ceremony.
13. Delegates violating any of these rules of conduct will subject their entire delegation to be unseated, and may cause their candidates or Skill Olympics entrants to be disqualified.
14. Delegates may be sent home at their own expense for violating any of these rules of conduct.
15. Standard rules that apply to school activities shall be in effect during the conference. The term delegate applies to all registered conference participants.
16. Unreasonably loud, rowdy, or other undesirable behavior, which is in contrast with the ideals of the SkillsUSA organization, will not be tolerated at any time at any location during the conference.
17. Students are responsible for removal of all posters or information placed on walls, bulletin boards, etc.
